First week in June came Momma Bertha's 88th birthday (Robin's mom); it was a great celebration...with family in the SC Low Country. We stayed a few days with our mothers. Tuesday of that week the Sunrise Kentucky Ladies served our Lord with Freedom Center Ministries...they shared Bible studies, sang songs, haircuts and nails. The team included ladies from Louisiana and Wisconsin.

The third week of June, Kershaw Baptist Association bought 10 churches on mission and 6 ladies of Hermitage BC Camden, SC...and 14 volunteers of Tennessee served. These mission teams helped organize, sort clothes, and other items, sang songs, shared Bible studies, prayed with and encouraged us and the local folks. New Life Community Church of Illinois bought clothes and furniture...we delivered some furniture to a local man that had a great need. The volunteer mission teams served our Lord with joy and glad hearts.

The fourth week of June, Highview BC Louisville, KY served with several Tri-City ministries. One team sorted and organized the warehouse with a goodwill run...stocked the FC shop, shared Bible studies, sang hymns, and face painted the children. A team of 3 men and Gerald's son served at the mission house they added two electrical outlets upstairs, installed a light fixture in the kitchen, donated cabinets to go over the washer/drier, installed an outside water faucet, water sealed the wooden deck, and relocated the dehumidifier in the basement. Those items completed: I gave a hallelujah shout and danced before the Lord...Praise our Lord!!

The Lord is amazing...Providence BC Orangeburg, SC mission team included Robin's cousin...we did not know he was coming and it had been years since their last reunion. The team served with FCM doing cut hairs, did a goodwill run; a team of three men got their paint brushes going...they painted a porch, painted a door and hung the door...pressure washed the house and all the cement walkways and covered patio.

The fifth week of June, Northside Community Church New Albany, IN arrived with a team of 103 that wore bright tie-dyed t-shirts. The team served in the Tri-City area with weed eaters and other landscaping tools. One family served at FCM as they stocked the shop with summer clothes and hung clothes for July "Back to School" project. The family shared testimony and the children sang and danced unto the Lord.

Some of the local folk encouraged us Tuesday with testimony of gratitude of thanksgiving. One lady said many families have been blessed through this ministry. Another lady said FC has clothed me and my daughter for years. These words came at a much needed time...when I wondered if we were really making a difference. That afternoon the Holy Spirit used me to share the Good News of Jesus with a young man...and to encourage him to take his son to church. Not to send him! Please pray for Saylor.

Father's blessings continue at FCM with our new missionary Linda Griffis. She has blessed the local folk in the Tri-City area with her gifts and talents. Robin and Linda get along very well. She has been in training the month of June...and Linda is a hard worker. She is a huge help...with a servant's heart. God is good...His timing is perfect!!!
